Non-Statutory Consultation

Kingfisher Solar Farm is a proposed solar farm being developed by renewable energy company Ørsted on land approximately three miles north of Beverley in East Riding of Yorkshire. The project would use the same cable route corridor as the consented Hornsea 4 Offshore Wind Farm scheme to connect into Creyke Beck substation and provide power to the national grid.

Kingfisher Solar Farm would have a capacity of approximately 320 megawatts (MW) of clean energy – enough to power 100,000 UK homes.

We are holding a non-statutory consultation on Kingfisher Solar Farm to hear the views of the community and gather local knowledge, which we will use to inform and develop our future proposals. The consultation will take place from Monday 3 February 2025, lasting five weeks until Sunday 9 March 2025.
